

URINARY TRACT SPECIMEN COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS PROVIDED

- 1 Sterile urine collection cup
- Vacutainer urine tube ® C&S Preservative (gray top)
- Castile Soap Towelette
- Biohazard bag

SPECIMEN COLLECTION

To ensure safety and viability of the sample, it is important to follow the instructions provided below.

CLEAN-CATCH PROCEDURE

A first morning sample collected longer than 1 - 2 hours since prior urination maximizes sensitivity of detecting urinary system pathogens.

PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water.
- 2. Make sure the container is labeled with your name and date of birth
- 3. Open specimen cup. Avoid touching the inside of the cup.

Females:

Separate the skin folded around the urinary tract opening then clean the genital area with a Castile soap wipe.

Males:

Retract the foreskin (if necessary) from the urinary tract opening then clean the genital area with a Castile soap wipe.

- 4. Urinate into the toilet for a few seconds and then stop the urine flow briefly.
- 5. Place the sterile urine collection container under the stream of urine and resume urinating to collect the sample.
- 6. Finish urinating into the toilet.
- 7. Tightly screw the lid of the urine specimen cup back on without touching the inside and set it aside.
